PRINCIPAL

Preliminary Aims and Objects:

1. To inculcate the message that 'A' for Allah, 'B' for Buddha, 'C' for Christ, 'G' for God.
2. To provide an environment where all-round development of the child can be built.
3. To develop a child as a strong and committed member of the global society.
4. To acquaint the child with Indian culture, art, drama, music, etc.
5. To inculcate special aptitude for learning, stimulating intellectual curiosity and directing and exercising the emotions.
6. To provide better foundation for higher education.

Our Staff:

The school provides a meritorious team of well qualified, experience, dedicated, trained and hard working teachers. They not only impart the bookish knowledge, but also prepare the children to maintain eternal, spiritual and cultural heritage of India in this fast changing political, social and economic scenario.

Syllabus:

Syllabus for pre-school students is interactive and activity-based that emphasizes learning by doing. The focus is on engaging the child and developing conceptual clarity and not on rote learning. For grade 1 onwards, the course is based on the guidelines provided in the National Curriculum Framework for School Education, 2005. It encompasses the spirit of the National Education Policy 2020, placing the learner at its core and adopting a holistic approach that ensures learning is enjoyed, retained and applied.

Examination Pattern:

For Play Group and Pre-primary classes continuous monitoring is done to gauge the performance of the child. The grade appraisal of the child is done on the internal assessment and observation of the teacher.

To grade the overall performance and development of grade 1 to 8 students, a uniform assessment scheme with a two-semester system is followed, which includes half yearly and annual examinations.

Curricular Activities:

For all-round development of a child, physical, mental and emotional growth is highly important. To motivate our navvians we have arranged games and sports, debates and quiz contests, group discussions, group tour, craft work and other activities like dance, music, drawing and painting etc. We have also arranged indoor games like badminton, table tennis, yoga and gymnastics.

School Uniform:

1. To provide homely atmosphere to the tiny tots of Play Group there is no formal uniform.
2. For Nursery and all other classes uniform will be as approved by the school.
3. No student will be allowed to sit in the class without proper uniform.

School Timings:

Play Group, Nursery, K.G. & Prep	8:30 a.m. to 12:30 (Summer) 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (Winter)
Play Group	Saturday (Holiday)
Grade 1 to 8	7:30 a.m. to 1:30 (Summer) 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (Winter)

Note:- Students will not be allowed to enter the class after the scheduled time.

Registration:

1. To register the name of the ward for Play Group the minimum age should be 2 and a half years and for Nursery class the minimum age should be 3 years.
2. No formal interview is required for the tiny tots of Play Group and Nursery classes.
3. To register the ward's necessary documents should be submitted.
